Maintenance Supervisor - Part-time position. 20-35 hours per week April - August, 10-20 hours per week September - March. The Maintenance Supervisor is responsible for the seasonal grounds and field crew. The Maintenance Supervisor will report directly to the Park District Director and provide a monthly report to the Park Board of Commissioners. Applicant should have knowledge and skills in carpentry, mechanics, recreational turf maintenance, and equipment operation. Must be able to lift a minimum of 100 lbs. Position requires bending, stooping, climbing, kneeling and other various strenuous activities.
