Tremont School District #702 will be holding an Early Childhood Screening on Thursday, February 7, 2019.

All children ages 0-5 living in District #702 are eligible. This is not a Turk Center or Kindergarten Screening. The purpose is to screen developmental levels in motor skills, general knowledge, social skills and speech/language skills in order to access the need for special education services. Further evaluation may be recommended. If you have concerns in the areas listed or would like reassurance
