Then vs. Now: Teachers Edition

At Tremont High School, around 25% of the teachers graduated from the same school. What is it about THS that draws people back?

To Mrs. Ballard, a teacher at THS, "Tremont has always felt like home."

While Ballard didn't graduate from Tremont, she has taught in the past when Ms. Ramlo and Mr. Imig, current teachers at THS, were students. Ballard mentioned she never wanted to leave Tremont, but her husband's career took her to El Paso, Texas, and then to St. Louis before she eventually returned to the Tremont area.

She shared several reasons for her return. "Still good kids, still good families, and it's a good place to be," she said.

When Ballard came back last year, "Seeing them at first was a little weird, but I quickly got over it," she said about Ramlo and Imig.

One thing Ballard remembers about Imig is his curly hair and his pie-making sister. Ramlo was always enthusiastic like she is today.

When it comes to the changes in the school, it's mainly the growth in student population, she said. There also wasn't as much technology in the classrooms as today.
